E-poster Guidelines

Please do not print and bring a poster onsite. All posters will be displayed digitally.

E-poster formatting

Please use the official [e-poster template](#) available on the conference platform.

Submit your e-poster in PPT or PPTX format.

All e-posters will be accessible on a PC with PowerPoint 2016. If you have prepared your poster in Mac PowerPoint format, we highly recommend that you test your e-poster in a Windows system beforehand. In order to avoid any PC and Mac compatibility issues, we strongly recommend that you only use fonts that are common to both systems (Arial, Courier, Courier New, Geneva, Georgia, Helvetica, Times, Times New Roman).

Discussion Sessions

E-poster discussion presentations are meant to be given onsite in Ohrid. There is no option to present online.

How long: 5 min presentations each (discussions will be held after a group of 5-10 presentations)

How: Presenters will present from their previously uploaded e-poster. The e-poster will be displayed, by our staff, at the e-poster station at the time of your presentation.

Where: E-poster presentations will take place in front of the e-poster stations onsite. Please view the programme to find your station, presentation date and time.

Please arrive at the e-poster station 15 minutes prior to the start of the session, to ask any questions and to receive instructions from the organizers. We appreciate you being able to stay for the entirety of the session, and not just for your presentation.

Online submission

We kindly ask the presenters to submit their e-poster on the Congress' platform.

It will not be possible to link your own laptop directly in the session room or to plug in your own memory stick onto the computer set-up in the room. If you anticipate any technical constraints, please contact an organizing member beforehand.
